The duties for this position will include but are not limited to reading blueprints and work orders, set-up and safe operation of a press brake, and the ability to work efficiently while safely producing high quality parts.

Required Skills:

Ability to read and interpret blueprints and work orders.

The ability to measure and verify dimensions using various measuring devices.

The ability to properly and safely operate a press brake from a variety of manufacturers.

The ability to work efficiently while safely producing high quality parts.

Preferred Skills:

The ability to identify, retrieve and install the required punches based on bend radius.

The ability to identify, retrieve and install the required dies based on material thickness.

The ability to program a press brake at the controller.

A complete understanding of fabrication mathematics.

The ability to troubleshoot, analyze and resolve operating and fabricating challenges.

1 year of press brake set-up, programming and operations.

2 years of fabrication experience.

Experience in a manufacturing environment.

High school diploma/GED

Ability to work well with others.

Blueprint reading skills.

Good math skills.

Ability to stand for 8 hours.

Ability to lift up to 50 pounds.
